Therapists provide in home services to families with children 0-3 years of age as a member of a trans-disciplinary team of professionals including OT, PT, SLP, and Special Educators. Experience with young children preferred. Experience in Early Intervention a plus.

Responsibilities include:

- Assess physical, sensory, and perceptual development of each child.
- Formulate IFSP to meet each child's needs in conjunction with the family.
- Provide services to the child and family in the natural setting as determined by the IFSP.
- Communicate effectively with staff, director, children and families.
- Complete all required reports, session sheets, updates, and annual reviews.
- Schedule family visits within acceptable timelines as per procedural safeguards.
- Participate in bi-monthly team meetings.

Requirements:

- Licensed Occupational Therapist, State of NJ Department of Law and Public Safety, Division of Consumer Affairs, Occupational Therapy Advisory Council.
- Preferably has at least one year documented professional experience with individuals from birth to five years of age who have developmental delays and disabilities.
