The Archway Lower School provides educational experiences for students ages 3 through 21 with Multiple Disabilities, Autistic Spectrum Disorder, and Communication Disabilities. Our students may also be challenged socially, neurologically and economically. Each classroom is comprised of approximately 7 students. Gifts for students facing these challenges are geared for sensory development. We can assist you by providing a recommendation of appropriate gifts for each student.

The Archway Upper School provides a wide variety of individualized programs for special-needs students ages 8 to 21. Children with communication disabilities, multiple handicaps, behavioral concerns and economic disadvantages. We can assist you by providing a recommendation of appropriate gifts for each student.

Children & Youth Partial Care provides mental health services in an after school Partial Care Program for emotionally disturbed children and adolescents who are at risk in Camden and Gloucester counties between the ages of five and eighteen. Our philosophy is that by providing a safe, consistent, structured and caring environment, we can help our consumers to discover their individual strengths and overcome their deficits in coping and social skills.

ACT (Adult Counseling & Therapy) A partial day treatment program addressing the unique needs of adults 18 years and older with severe persistent mental illness. Consumers learn critical skills in order to achieve valued community roles and integration.

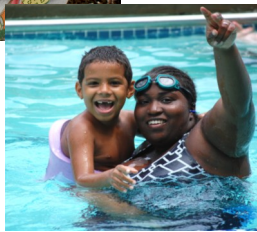
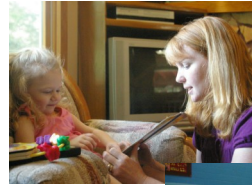

CHILDREN'S PROGRAMS

- **Early Intervention Evaluation Team**-Provides evaluations to children under three for developmental delays and develops Individual Family Service Plans.
 - **Step by Step** - Early Intervention provided to children with developmental disabilities from birth to 3 in natural environment.
- Just Kids** - Before and After School child care sponsored in child's school. Providing care in sixteen school districts throughout South Jersey.



PRIVATE SCHOOLS FOR THE HANDICAPPED

- **Lower School: Atco**- Provides instruction in functional academic and life skills for children ages 3-21, including Preschool Handicapped, who experience multiple disabilities, autism and medical involvement.
- **Upper School: Evesham** - Provides transitional and prevocational academic instruction to elementary, middle and high school students experiencing learning, language, autistic and behavioral disabilities.



HUMAN SERVICES PROGRAMS

• PARTIAL CARE SERVICES

Children & Youth Partial Care:

H.O.P.E.—Sewell and

D.I.S.C.O.V.E.R.—Williamstown

Provides mental health services to children and adolescents who are severely emotionally disturbed.

ACT (Adult Counseling & Therapy): Williamstown

Partial day treatment designed for adults with severe and persistent mental illness.

• DIVISION OF DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES SERVICES

Group Homes: Supervised homes are available for adults with developmental disabilities.

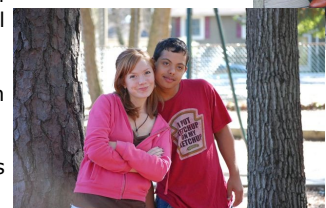
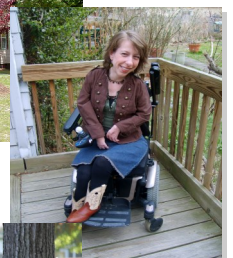
Respite Care/REFIL: Provide short term relief to caretakers of children and adults with disabilities.

Supportive Living: Provides support to persons with developmental disabilities living on their own in the community.

Fun Saturdays: Saturday drop off respite program for people with developmental disabilities. Program operates from 1pm—5 pm at Archway Programs' Lower School in Atco.

Summer Respite: A drop off summer respite program for persons with developmental disabilities ages 5-22.

Positive Encounters: Serves youngsters from ages 8-17 who live in foster homes through a program that combines respite and structured recreational type services.
